North Perry Athletes Code of Conduct

North Perry athletes are expected to represent themselves and their team with high moral character, sportsmanship, and upstanding integrity. Whether it be academically, athletically, or socially, athletes must carry themselves in an appropriate and respectful manner. Participation on a sports team is considered to be a privilege, not a given right. Moreover, participation has many benefits and brings with it an enormous responsibility to be positive and effective members of a team, athletic program, organization, and community. It is expected that all athletes abide by team, athletic program, and organization rules. Athletes who do not conform to this code are subject to consequences for their actions. The severity of any misconduct and violation of rules will be assessed at the discretion of the coach and NP board members. Penalties may include warnings, suspension, or dismissal from the organization's athletic program.

North Perry Gator Athletes will abide by the following:

- Treat teammates, coaches, officials and opponents with respect and kindness
- Encourage teammates and celebrate team success more than individual success
- Show up ready to learn, practice, play and try your best even when something is difficult
- Show good sportsmanship: shake hands, say "good game" and be respectful of officials decisions
- Use appropriate language- no name-calling, teasing or rude comments
- Be a good teammate by encouraging others and helping new players feel welcome

Prohibited behaviours that will not be tolerated and penalties that may be enforced

- No bullying, harassing or hazing which include making fun of others for mistakes, skill level or differences
- No fighting, roughhousing or unsafe behaviors
- No swearing or using disrespectful language toward teammates, coaches or officials

North Perry wants to hold our athletes to the highest standards. Failure of an athlete to abide by this code of conduct will result in the following:

1st Offense: Coach will discuss the situation with the player and explain the consequences of their actions.

2nd Offense: Coach, athlete and parent will have a conversation about the problem and discuss consequences

3rd Offense: Athlete may be suspended for 1 game. The NP board will discuss the situation and vote on if a suspension is warranted.

4th Offense: Athlete may be suspended for the remainder of the season. The NP board will discuss the situation and vote on if a suspension is warranted.

The coach has the right to determine if the player should be benched/suspended before they get to a 3rd offense if they feel it is warranted. They will inform the parent and NP board of the situation, reasoning and decision.

Note: If the same behaviour continues in a different sport, the athlete may not be able to continue to play for the NP organization.
